A large 3-digit LCD display is provided for monitoring the countdown of the timer.

This timer may only be installed by a qualified, licensed electrician and must be installed in accordance with National and local codes.




WARNING DO NOT install the timer in a wet or damp location.

**IMPORTANT:** A steam vent (PN 104072) must be installed in the steam line between the steam generator and the steam solenoid valve when using a 30 minute timer. The steam vent will release hydrostatic pressure in the boiler while filling when the 30 minute timer has timed out.

DIP switches used to change timer setting. Refer to PUR 100383 for programming details.
